Job Summary

Reporting to the Director of Media Services, Sound Engineers provide audio, lighting, and/or video support for various events including, but not limited to church services, memorial services, weddings, Yoga on the Labyrinth, The Forum, Sound Baths, concerts, meetings, and space rentals by outside groups.

This is a part-time non-exempt with irregular scheduling not to exceed 18 hours a week on average.

Working at Grace Cathedral

Grace Cathedral is San Francisco's Episcopal cathedral for everyone – a place of inclusive community and spiritual practice, social justice work, music, arts, yoga, and more. Our mission is to reimagine church with courage, joy, and wonder.

For most positions, it is not required to belong to or practice a particular faith to work here, although everyone on our team is expected to be aligned with the vision, mission, and values of Grace Cathedral and contribute to achieving its strategic goals.

Job Duties

- Provide audio support for a variety of services & events.
- Maintain knowledge of the building's acoustics.
- Maintain familiarity with different service & event setups.
- Retain familiarity with all equipment in use.

- Provide onsite support for clients.
- Retrieve all gear and neatly store at the end of a service or event.
- Provide A/V/L setup, event support (equipment operation), breakdown, and storage of equipment for services & events.
- Follow all health and safety policies and procedures required by the cathedral.
- Attend meetings and trainings as assigned.
- Other tasks and duties as assigned.

Job Requirements

- Alignment with the vision, mission and values of Grace Cathedral and commitment to contribute to achieving its strategic priorities and goals.
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent technical training preferred; Dante Certification a plus.
- At least two years of live sound experience; broadcast/recording sound experience a plus.
- Strong understanding of A/V signal flow; experience on Allen & Heath digital audio consoles a plus.
- Basic understanding of lighting software (Vista 3) a plus.
- Proficient in Microsoft Office Outlook, Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.
- Strong spoken and written communication skills in English.
- Strong relationship skills and ability to work with to interact courteously and respectfully with all staff, volunteers, trustees, congregation members, visitors, vendors, space rental clients, and staff from the Cathedral School for Boys and the Diocese of California.
- Ability to work cooperatively as a member of a team and independently, and ability to work tactfully under pressure.
- Exceptional judgment, discretion, attention to detail, work ethic, and commitment to excellence.
- Must be able to work Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.
- Must be available to work Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Easter, and the night before Ash Wednesday.
- Essential functions of this position require the ability to sit for extended periods, stand, reach, bend, lift, climb stairs, carry up to 50 pounds.
