



## SING FOR PLEASURE

As of August 2024

Visiting choirs are welcome to perform at Grace Cathedral.

### AN OVERVIEW:

- *Sing for Pleasure* performances must be scheduled at least two weeks in advance.
- Choirs are scheduled to perform Monday through Thursdays from 1 to 3 p.m.
- We do not book *Sing for Pleasure* groups on weekends or during the weeks immediately before Christmas or Easter.
- Choral groups may sing for up to 30 minutes, unaccompanied. Additional time may be arranged for an additional fee.
- Both sacred and secular music are welcomed.
- The cathedral does not accept requests for instrumental performances.

### ARRANGEMENTS AND FEES:

- Choirs may schedule their half-hour performances on Mondays through Thursdays, by availability as the cathedral calendar allows.
- Sing For Pleasure fees are \$15 per chorister with a maximum fee of \$525 and a minimum of \$200.
- One-hour guided Highlights tours may be added to the *Sing for Pleasure* fees at the cost of \$6/person. See [gracecathedral.org/visit](http://gracecathedral.org/visit) for more information.
- Up to an equivalent number of non-choristers arriving with the choir receive complimentary admission. (Please note that the cathedral charges admission for sightseeing Monday through Saturdays, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sundays, 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.)
- Performances may be reserved by contacting [events@gracecathedral.org](mailto:events@gracecathedral.org).
- Fees are payable upon receipt of the invoice via check or major credit card and must be paid before arrival.
- Fees may be reduced or waived in certain circumstances. Please contact [events@gracecathedral.org](mailto:events@gracecathedral.org) if needed.

### UPON ARRIVAL:

- Choirs should check in at the visitor desk inside the cathedral. Please be on time, as extending the end time due to lateness is not possible.
- Choristers should arrive dressed and ready to sing, as no dressing or warm-up rooms will be provided.
- Choirs are welcome to warm up in the cathedral space during the first few minutes of their performance, but due to liturgical services and other scheduled events, they cannot warm up prior to their scheduled performance time.
- Recording devices must be battery powered, as there is no access to electrical outlets.
- Buses may park in the white zone on California Street in front of the cathedral. Grace Cathedral does not guarantee parking.
- Choristers and those accompanying them are welcome to stay after their performance and enjoy a self-guided interactive tour of the cathedral. Docent-led guided tours are available for an additional fee (as above) and must also be scheduled in advance.
