What to bring

 - Please bring treasures that are complete (if part of a set), clean and in working order
 - We ask that donated items can be transported easily (in a car/on public transport)

When to bring it!

In advance:

On the day:

- Bring items from 12 -12:30 pm to the Dining Room, on the plaza of Grace Cathedral.

- Our swap will start at 12:30 pm; it will take place in the Dining Room on the plaza and be signposted.
- It is free to participate. The idea of the swap is that participants leave items and take other items.
- Remaining items will be gifted to selected non-profits.

Who can participate?

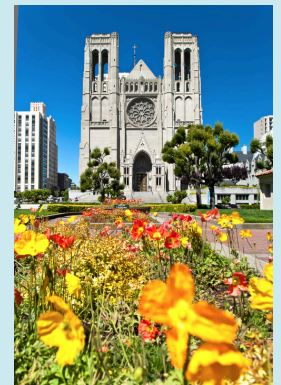
- All are warmly invited to this community event.
